Enrollment Policies 2026-2027

**** Registration Policy**

Registration for classes commits a student to a **FULL SCHOOL-YEAR CALENDAR, August-May** (except as noted in a few one-semester classes).

Classes for your students need to be consecutive, or you need to plan to pick them up during any breaks. We do not have any capacity for tracking/supervising students who are not in classes here on our campus. Please plan accordingly!

**** Registration Fees**

Registration fee for students returning from 25/26 school year is **\$25/family**.

Registration fees for new families is **\$40/family**, and there is an additional **\$35** due as a deposit toward the 1st month's bill. This will hold your spots in the classes you want to register for into the first week of classes. Without the additional fee, your registration will not be considered complete. **These fees are all non-refundable.**

**** Payment Policy**

The bill for the entire school year will be divided evenly into ten monthly payments, running August - May. Payments will be due on the **first (1st)** day of your student's classes every month, and late fees may apply after the **first week**.

**** Drop or Add Policy**

After classes have begun, you will be given **3 WEEKS** to drop a class but after that date it is assumed your student **will finish the school year in the class**. Once you have passed the drop window of 3 weeks, you are responsible for payment whether your student attends or not. If extenuating circumstances arise, please alert our office and set up a meeting with our Director to discuss.

**** Snow or Weather Policy**

In the case of snow, severe weather or weather warnings, Peachtree makes its own independent decision to close separate from any other entity. Our decision will be emailed to all on our mailing list and posted on our Instagram & Facebook pages as early as possible on the day in question. Any classes that can happen in a virtual environment will happen at the regular time or make-up classes will be scheduled when possible. Private lessons will be made up at the discretion of you and your private instructor within Peachtree's availability.

**** Class Fees**

All classes are \$9/class with exceptions as follows:

**** Discounts:**

For all arts classes, these discounts apply:

Multi-child Discount : (According to number of classes)

- Two students with most number of classes (at least 2 classes each) - Full Price
- Third Child - Half Price
- Fourth Child & successive - Free

*There are no discounts applied to JH/HS academic-only students, but students enrolled in arts AND academics can still qualify for multiple child discounts.
