Cancellation Policy

As apart of my contract with Peachtree Learning Center, I am required to support the following cancellation policies. In the event of a missed lesson, please note the following:

- Tuition is only refunded in the event of the instructor's absence and a make-up lesson cannot be scheduled.
- If you know, in a minimum of 24 hrs notice, that you will be absent, your instructor will do his best to have a make-up lesson time available.
- If your child becomes sick and needs to be absent, please let your instructor know as soon as possible. Your instructor will do his best to schedule a make-up lesson if possible.

Per our insurance policy, if Peachtree Learning Center has to close due to inclement weather, every activity held in the building that day must be canceled. If a make up lesson cannot be provided, the student will be credited for that. Peachtree may not have time to make a call on cancellation in a chance of serious weather. If the teacher or the parent feels unsafe traveling, a make-up lesson will be offered.

During the summer and other extended breaks, I may offer lessons outside of Peachtree's calendar.

Practice Requirements

I would like for my students to practice with a metronome three to five days a week. The length of their practice time will differ according to their skill level.

For my younger students, I would like them to practice for a minimum of 15 minutes a day. For my advanced students, a minimum of 30 minutes.

Practice at your own pace.

Do not be disheartened and/or stressed out if you haven't gotten down a certain chord change or if you haven't memorized a certain scale in time for our lesson. Understand though it might take you a while to learn or grasp what we go over in our lesson, does not mean you don't have the ability or know how to do it. I will be nothing but understanding towards you and will do the best that I'm able to help reach your goal.

Nevertheless, you as the student are responsible for your practice time, not your instructor.

Always, if possible, go to your local music store to buy your instrument and their experts will answer any questions you might have. On top of that if they don't have what you need in stock, they will order the instrument for you.
