## Enrollment Policies 2023-2024

### \*\* Registration Policy

Registration for classes commits a student to a **full school year calendar, August-May** (except as noted in a few one-semester classes). Each student must submit the following release forms: Medical, Photo/Video Release, Lost & Found, and Liability. The Liability Release Form must be notarized. The registration fee is **\$40/new family, \$25/existing family**. Unless otherwise noted (see class descriptions), there is a \$10 material fee per class per semester for all classes.

### \*\* Payment Policy

Payments will be due in 4-week cycles, due the **FIRST WEEK** of each cycle, **NOT** per month.

### \*\* Drop or Add Policy

1. After classes have begun, you will be given **3 weeks** to drop a class but after that date it is assumed your student **will finish the school year in the class**. Once you have passed the drop window of 3 weeks, you are responsible for payment whether your student attends or not. In the case of extended illness or moving away from the Cookeville area this policy may be approved for waiver or partial waiver.

### \*\* Snow or Weather Policy

In the case of snow, severe weather or weather warnings, Peachtree makes its own independent decision to close or not, separate from institutions including the public school systems. Our decision will be emailed to all on our mailing list and posted on our Instagram & Facebook pages as early as possible on the day in question. Make-up classes will be scheduled when possible. If make-up classes are not scheduled you will be refunded for canceled classes. Private lessons will be made up at the discretion of you and your private instructor within Peachtree's availability.

### \*\* Class Fees

All classes are \$8/class with exceptions as follows:

\$10 Jr High Academics, 1.5 hr Classes, and Reading Foundations Classes.  
\$15 High School Academics.

### \*\* Discounts:
